



East Oshawa Cooperative Preschool Inc. Pre-Registration Package

Hard to believe but it's time to think about pre-registering for the 2010 - 2011 preschool year. Our Preschool program for 2 to 4 year olds will be offered four mornings a week from 9:00 am to 11:30 am and our JK Alternative program five afternoons a week. Families may choose from a two morning program (Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs) a three morning program (3 of Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs), a four morning program (Mon to Thurs) and a five afternoon program (Mon-Fri).

One of the benefits of sending your child to a co-operative preschool is the opportunity to be actively involved in your child's education. As we are a non-profit organization, in order to keep tuition costs down while still offering an above average preschool program, we rely on families to participate in volunteer days and fundraising campaigns. We can also accommodate families who are unable to volunteer physically in the school.

Attached you will find an information sheet explaining some of the cooperative preschool terms and a copy of the pre-registration form. If you would like to pre-register for one of the 2010-2011 programs, please complete this form and return it with the \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee. Once the completed pre-registration form and a cheque have been received, a program spot will be reserved for your child. Pre-Registration at E.O.C.P.

The following are terms associated with membership at East Oshawa Cooperative Preschool. Before completing the pre-registration form, please read these carefully to understand your choices for membership and fundraising at our school.

Volunteer days consist of either covering the snack area or creative area and downstairs areas of the school. When on a snack volunteer day, you are required to provide and serve a snack to the preschool students on that day. In the creative and/or downstairs areas, you will help children place artistic creations on the drying rack, ensure all artwork is labeled with the child's name, clean the easels and tables when the creative centers close, and supervise children engaged in downstairs gross motor activities. It is the scheduled volunteer parents, combined with our three teaching staff, who maintain our great adult to child ratio of 1:5.

A **criminal reference check** is required by all parents and/or care-givers who will be actively involved in volunteer days at the preschool.

Duty or Non-Duty describes your level of membership with EOCP. A duty family will be scheduled a volunteer day once every three to six weeks. If you are not able to participate in volunteer days, you will be considered Non-Duty.

Fundraising consists of purchasing or selling to family and friends a variety of products offered through fundraising campaigns throughout the school year. We ask each family to raise \$100.00 which is easy to accumulate as the campaigns offer 10% to 100% profit towards your fundraising commitment. In the past we have run McMillans (pizza, dips, appetizers, cookie and muffin mix); Raffles - with hockey tickets, gift certificates for massage, shopping and dining out; Spring flower bulbs; Holiday poinsettias and arrangements; Purdy's Chocolate Bars; 50/50 draw. There are too many campaigns to mention, but many to choose from so you are not buying or selling a product you will not use!

Active Fundraisers are those families who commit to participate in fundraising for the school to meet their \$100.00 commitment. **Inactive Fundraisers** are those families who do not want to participate in fundraising and who will pay the \$125.00 fundraising fee at the beginning of the school year.
